ALOHA Island Colony Partners - In March, the Hawaii Tourism Authority (HTA) issued research studies offering comprehensive findings about the profiles, preferences and sentiments of LGBT travelers as it relates to Hawaii. Noteworthy points from the U.S. study include the following:

- 70% of those surveyed consider Hawaii an LGBT-friendly destination, but only 27% expressed interest in making a trip to the Islands in the next two years.
- Hawaii is competing against sun and surf destinations in Florida and southern California, as well as urban destinations like San Francisco, Las Vegas and Western Europe.
- The typical LGBT U.S. visitor to Hawaii has a household income of more than \$100,000. 71% of LGBT U.S. visitors to Hawaii travel with a partner.

PROJECTED APRIL RESULTS


Currently the month of April is pacing behind last year, and we will likely fall about \$9K short of revenue goals for the month. Pick-up and demand for April has been weak during the second half of the month. At the end of the month, the Waikiki Spam Jam festival will bring in great revenue and occupancy as we close out the month on a high note.

FUTURE OUTLOOK

The month of May will be a struggle to surpass revenue goals for the month as we are pacing behind last year. Our Sales and Marketing Team has revamped our website and have been running promotions to help gain business. Summer months are pacing well, even without RIMPAC this year. We look to gain great base and build on rate and occupancy as we move closer to the summer booking window.

PARTNERSHIP NEWS

In our ongoing efforts to enforce the 30-day minimum rental restrictions, the Partnership office is continually monitoring online rental activities in addition to notifying owners and agents who may be in violation of the 30-day rule.





AOAO UPDATE

One Bedroom Window Replacement: Contractors have started one bedroom window replacement on the 20-21 stacks on the ocean side of the building. Work continues daily, weather permitting.

Driveway: On Monday, March 27, 2017 contractors started masonry work in the lobby/porte cochere area in order to meet ADA requirements. Work continues and is expected to be completed by the end of the month.

Pool Deck Bathroom Renovations: Contractors have started work on renovating the restrooms on the 6th floor common area. Work will finish by the end of May.

RENOVATION STATUS

We are currently finalizing bids to replace deteriorating curtains in the one bedroom units. With the AOAO's installation of the new windows in the one-bedroom units, this will be a nice touch added to the units. Once this has been approved, work will commence
